The community park has been a work in progress for RRROCA since 2007 when the Community Association began surveying residents to obtain feedback of what they would like to see in their community. Feedback showed that a skating rink was consistently the top priority, and over time, the concept for the community park grew to include a more diverse range of passive and active amenities to appeal to a wider range of users.

“We are excited to contribute a new opportunity for recreation in our communities. The creation of the park was meant to fill a void in Rocky Ridge and Royal Oak for a public, multigenerational and multi-use outdoor amenity. We feel we have helped to fill that void and are pleased to see it being put to use already.
