Heather MacKay (NPC, City of Calgary)

- Provided a brief intro for the new board members
- COVID
 - Reopening information is available from BIZ Connect website (Alberta Health Services). Shahnaz will
 compile information for board members.
 - The City of Calgary has allocated \$6M for community associations to offset lost revenue and additional
 costs incurred due to shut-down. Could include up to 75% of eligible facility operating costs, which may
 include: insurance, water, power, maintenance, and lost revenue. Abreen will populate a flow chart
 required for the application.
 - o Heather is encouraging community associations to submit applications sooner rather than later.
- Heather has neighborhood cleanup kits available and will drop them off.
